# UK PARLIAMENTARY RECEPTION FOR KORT

The Kashmir Orphans Relief Trust team was given a Parliamentary Reception at the House of Commons, in London, on 31st March 2008 by the Honourable Member of Parliament Marsha Singh, to celebrate KORT's achievements. The event was attended by the honourable Prime Minister of AJK, Sardar Attique Ahmed Khan; the Deputy High Commissioner of Pakistan, Abdul Basit; the UK Sports Minister, Gerry Sutcliffe MP; the UK Minister for International Development, Shahid Malik MP. Also present were business people and community leaders from across the United Kingdom.

Marsha Singh, in his opening speech commended the KORT team for achieving so much in a very short time. He particularly paid tribute to our chairperson Mohammed Akhtar, whom he affectionately described as 'action man' for his tenacity, drive, boundless energy and determination for getting things done.

The Prime Minister, Sardar Attique Ahmed Khan, came especially for this event despite a very busy schedule. He spoke with pride in acknowledging KORT's genuineness, transparency and achievements. The PM commended the very positive contributions

being made by people of all backgrounds both here in the UK and around the world. He restated his commitment and support to KORT in alleviating any bureaucratic blockages in furthering our aims, objectives and vision. Messages of support were also received from all of the keynote speakers

A presentation was delivered to an audience of over 150 selected business people and community leaders focussing on the progress made thus far. In particular highlighting the educational achievements of existing children, the development of the new Complex in Jarrikas, Mirpur, AJK and the various fund raising initiatives/awareness raising seminars.

Sajad Hussain of Sathi Food Products, Bradford said, 'I am honoured and privileged to be a part of this event and to be associated with KORT and I am donating £30000 for Marketing & Promotional costs for the next 12 months'.

#### Welcome

to KORT's second newsletter in which we hope to provide you with an update on the developments since our last newsletter in December 07.

We have had to modify the original plans for the educational complex to take into consideration health and safety requirements which had inadvertently been overlooked. The health and wellbeing of all our students and staff is paramount and clearly we have a duty of care for all of them. Hence the changes. See fig 1. for an aerial view of the new complex.

The most exciting and significant news to report is that the preparation work on the 100 kanals of land donated by the Kashmiri government for the orphanage has commenced and is progressing.

The ground levelling stages are nearing completion despite, experiencing initial problems with workforce and machinery and inclement weather. The work on the water well which began in December 07 has recently been completed. The water has been tested at an approved Laboratory and has been certified fit for consumption. Construction work on Phase 1, the school and admin block is due to start in May 2008.




# **Fund Raising**


