Following this visit, our chairman Ch. Mohammed Akhtar also met with Rana Atif and Aaqib Javed of the Lahore Qalanders Cricket Club in January 2019 to discuss future collaboration for the support of KORT. Both men agreed to become ambassadors for KORT, and plans were made to organise a charity cricket match in Mirpur between the Lahore Qalanders and a selected team from KORT very soon to raise awareness and gain further support for KORT and our orphan children.
